



Dear Players and Guests, Sangha Members and Friends of the Sacramento Buddhist Church,

You are cordially invited to participate in the 10th Annual Sacramento Buddhist Church Golf Tournament held at the Teal Bend Golf Course on Wednesday, August 21, 2019. Be sure to sign up and submit your registration as soon as possible as tee time are limited for this event.

The tournament entry of \$125 per golfer includes a round of golf and cart, future use complimentary green fee and cart (bounce back) certificate, morning pastries and coffee, on-course refreshments, tee prizes, lunch and monetary donation to the Sacramento Buddhist Church (Betsuin). The luncheon is open to the player's family and non-golfer friends.

The tournament will be played under the modified scramble format, known as shamble, similar to last year's event. After each golfer tees a ball into play; the group selects the spot from one of the teed balls to play their second shot (scramble), and continues under individual stroke-play conditions until they have finished the hole. The tournament committee will conduct a random "blind draw" from the field of players to form four-person teams for tournament prizes. There will be individual prizes for the closest-to-pin contests in addition to the team event.

Tee box sponsorships are available at the gold, silver, bronze, individual, "In Memory Of" and group sponsorship levels. The donor's name and sponsorship level will be displayed at the teeing area of selected holes. The bronze, silver and gold tee box sponsorships include complimentary green fees from one to four golfers and guaranteed entry into the golf tournament.
